- Students are required to come to 7 lessons a quarter.
- If students come to more than 7, their lowest grades will be dropped.
 - 5 points extra credit will be given to any student who attends nine lessons in a quarter.
- If student misses a lesson, I will mark it late in the grade book until it is made up.
- Students are able to make up lessons on Fridays when I am at the school or after school.
